SUBJECT: School / Class Tardiness				

Policy Purpose The purpose of this policy is to inform students of their responsibility to arrive to school and class on time in order to help prevent school, and class disruption due to tardiness.

Policy Information

Teachers and Administrators have indicated excessive student tardiness to both school and class. Getting to school or class on time is important to the educational experience at ACS. Tardiness is disruptive to both morning opening, and classes. Students should observe class start times as not to disrupt teachers and or fellow students because of tardiness.

5205.1 Arriving to school after 8:10 or arriving to class three minutes late is considered tardy.

5205.2 Tardiness beyond ten minutes may be counted as an unexcused absence.

5205.3 Being tardy for school or class three times per semester can result in detention or other suitable discipline.

5205.4 If there are repeat violations, student may receive a zero from the affected teachers. Administrators will arrange a meeting with the parents to discuss further consequences.

5205.5 Excessive repeat violations throughout the school year may require a parental meeting with the ACS school board.
